

Make a Paper Plate Plane




You will need:

- Access to a printer (optional)
- 2 paper plates
- A lolly stick
- Cotton wool
- White paper
- Coloured pens or paint
- Scissors
- Glue




Cut one of the paper plates in half with a wavy line and cut a small triangular gap on the bottom of the other.



Make sure the gap is wider than your lolly stick.

If you have access to a printer, print out the Paper Plate Plane template at the end of this document on white paper. If not, hand draw a plane shape.



Cut out the plane shape from the paper.

Paint or colour in both plates a bright blue like the sky.




If you paint them, leave them to dry completely.

Colour in the plane in a contrasting, bright colour. We chose red.



Pull apart the cotton wool into small pieces.

To make clouds, stick the pieces of cotton wool onto the half plate and onto the top part of the whole plate.



Stick the two plates together, putting the glue along the bottom edge of the whole plate.

Leave the glue to dry completely.



Place a dab of glue on the end of the lolly stick and stick the plane down at this end.

Again, let the glue dry completely, holding the plane onto the lolly stick.



Slide the lolly stick into the front and through the gap in the back. Now your Paper Plate Plane is ready to fly!
