

Meet Sid the Snake



You will need:

- Glue
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Colouring pens or crayons
- Kitchen roll cardboard tube
- Teaspoon

Place the teaspoon at the end of the cardboard tube and trace around the tip of the spoon to create a snakehead.




Leave a slightly wide opening to allow for drawing the snake's body.



Draw two parallel lines starting at the head opening and wrap around the tube to create the body.




Draw some eyes and nose onto the snakehead.



Colour and decorate the snake's body in any pattern you choose.

Carefully cut out your snake from the cardboard tube. Ask a grown up for help if necessary.

Use some of the leftover card to make a tongue and glue in place. You could also colour the underside of your snake.
