There is no download, you simply connect to the service online using any internet enabled device – PC, MAC, mobile phone – and read the books online, just as you read a website



Select the Public Library Online link to access the shelves.







Once within the Public Library Online you can view the selection of shelves...

Click shelf title or book jacket that you would like to view, using left and right arrows to scroll along all available titles on each shelf



- Click on the shelf you're interested in
- Click on the book you're interested in
- Start reading
- Zoom in to increase type size
- Search
- Enjoy!

Click on the jacket or 'read online' to begin reading

Read the blurb and click links to access lots of free resources including reading group guides, author interviews, videos, websites and reviews


Once you are in the reader, where you read pages from the book, you cannot bookmark or copy and paste the link or you will receive the following error message:



Go straight to any page in the book


Search through the book at any time

START WITH A SQUIGGLE

This is just the thing for those who feel like doing a bit of drawing but have no idea what to draw.

Get a piece of paper and a pen. Draw a squiggle, doodle, pattern or shape anywhere on the paper, making sure that a fair amount of room is left elsewhere on the page. Look at the squiggle, turning your page any which way you like, and see if you can turn it into the start of a new drawing. So for instance, draw some curvy lines as if you were drawing the top of a cloud. Then think of what else it could be: the top of a tree, a sheep, a friendly dinosaur with a bumpy back, a frog's head with bulgy eyes, etc. The top-half of a cloud turned on its side could be the beginnings of a monster's hand coming round a door. Held upside down, it could be the start of a comedy car with big bumpers and crooked wheels.

This game also works well if there is a group of children; everyone makes a squiggle and then hands it on to the person sitting next to them. If there is a baby or toddler around, then let them do all the squiggles — it makes them feel very important.

Click on the search bar and type in the word you are looking for

Which device?

- You can access the Public Library Online using any internet enabled device that uses Flash.
- This means most pcs, macs, laptops and mobile phones.
- Currently, iPad, iPhone and iTouch don't accept Flash, so the books cannot be viewed on these devices, but we're working on a solution



Can I use my Kindle or Sony Reader?

 No, because these are not fully internet enabled in that they don't allow access to all websites (Kindle just allows access to the Amazon store to buy books from Amazon)

 Those are ebook download devices whereas this is an online access service
